## Standard Statement of AISA Rules

1. The use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs is not allowed during travel or while in the host city during the time of the AISA event.
2. Any sightseeing or travel in the host city will be done only with the permission of the host family and the coach/director.
3. Under no circumstances will housing arrangements be changed without permission of the host school and the knowledge of the coach/director.
4. Visiting students will be in the home of the host family no later than the AISA curfew (10:00 pm), or at a time as soon as possible after a scheduled activity is completed as set by the host activities director or event director.
5. There will be no attendance of parties, unless school affiliated, permission granted, and chaperoned.
6. All laws of the host country must be adhered to.
7. Any unusual circumstances or problems which occur during the stay in the host city will be reported as soon as is possible to the host school activities director and the visiting coach/director.
8. For any serious breach of the AISA rules, please refer to the AISA disciplinary procedures listed in section 24 of the AISA handbook.
