## Sabers Invitational MS Girls Soccer Tournament REGULATIONS

- One pool of 6 teams. All teams play each other except for A \& B teams from same school.
- Pool play points: Win $=3$ points; Loss $=0$ points; Draw $=1$ point.
- Seeding: Points from round-robin play - 4 matches per team - determine seeding for championship round.
- Championship round: One match per team: $5^{\text {th }}$ vs $6^{\text {th }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ vs $4^{\text {th }}, 1^{\text {st }}$ vs $2^{\text {nd }}$.
- Trophies: $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$. Golden Boot for top scorer.
- Match length: 20-minute halves, 5-minute halftime. 5 minutes between matches. Next teams take field immediately upon completion of previous match. Be ready, be prompt.
- Squad size: 8 players on the field, plus designated subsitutes.
- Cross-over of players between A and B teams: Not allowed, including substitutes switching between squads, even if it means a team plays with fewer than 8 players. Schools are expected to field full separate squads for both $A$ and $B$ teams.
- Unlimited number of substitutions: Only the team in possession may substitute on a throw-in. Either team may substitute on a goal kick, corner kick, or free kick.
- Extra time: No extra trime for $5^{\text {th }}-6^{\text {th }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}-4^{\text {th }}$ place matches. Championship match only: 25 -minute periods of extra time.
- Kicks from penalty mark at end of tied match: $5^{\text {th }}-6^{\text {th }}$ place match: no PKs. $3^{\text {rd }}-4^{\text {th }}$ place match: yes, PKs (but no extra time). Championship match: PKs after extra time, if needed. See notes below.
- Yellow and red cards: Referees may issue yellow and red cards for foul play, excessive complaining, swearing, and other unsportsmanlike conduct. A player receiving a red card or a second yellow card will be ejected from the match (no replacement permitted) and suspended from the next match. (Yellow cards do not accumulate from match to match.)


## TIEBREAKERS

If 2 teams finish round-robin play with the same number of points, the first tie breaker will be the head-to-head result.

If 2 teams finish round-robin play with the same number of points and also drew with each other in head-to-head play, or if 3 or more teams in the same pool finish round-robin play with the same number of points, the tie breakers below shall be used in the order listed. After any one tie-breaker, if only 2 teams remain tied, the head-to-head result breaks the tie. If 3 teams remain tied, move on to the next tiebreaker.

1. Goal differential among tied teams (goals scored minus goals conceded; maximum of 5 goals counted per match)
2. Goals scored among tied teams (maximum of 5 goals counted per match)
3. Goals conceded among tied teams (maximum of 5 goals counted per match)
4. Jan-ken.

## Sabers Invitational MS Girls Soccer Tournament

"Kicks from the penalty mark" shootout, elimination matches only
based on pages 55-57 of FIFA rulebook 2015-16, "Procedures to determine the winner of a match"
a. Kicks from the penalty mark (PK shootout) occur after the end of the $3^{\text {rd }}-4^{\text {th }}$ place match if tied, and after extra time in the final championship match.
b. Kicks are taken at the goal nearest the school gymnasium.
c. Winner of jan ken or coin toss chooses to kick first or defer.
d. Each team takes 5 kicks and the kicks shall be taken alternately.
e. If, before both teams have taken 5 kicks, one team has scored more goals than the other could score from all 5 of its kicks, no more kicks shall be taken.
f. Only the 8 players on the field at the end of extra time are eligible to take a kick from the pentaly mark.
g. Each kick is taken by a different player and no player may take a second kick until all eligible players (including the goalkeeper) have taken a kick.
h. A goalkeeper may be replaced at any time by - and only by - an eligible player on the field. (If the goalkeeper is injured, she may be replaced by a substitute player.)
i. If a tie exists after 5 kicks, kicks continue to be taken - beginning with the remaining 3 eligible players on the field who have not already kicked - until a team has scored 1 goal more than the other.
